CALL FOR ABSTRACTS / CASES

Upon abstract submission authors will have to choose the research group where the abstract fits the best. Research abstracts can be sent to the following research groups: BASL/BLIC, BIRD, BSGIE, Digestive Pathology, BeSPGHAN, Radiology/Nuclear Medicine, BGDO, GIREM, Nutrition and Pancreas(BPC), Proctology.

The abstracts will be selected by the selection committee of each research group for oral or poster presentation. All abstracts will be scored anonymously, based on originality and scientific value.

The results of the selection will be communicated to the submitting authors by the end of December 2019.

AWARDS

- BASL session: 2 awards (1 in Basic Research and 1 in Clinical Research) for the best oral presentation, awarded on Thursday afternoon.
- BGDO, BIRD and BeSPGHAN will all grant 1 award.
- Working Group of Digestive Pathology best oral presentation and best poster awarded on Friday afternoon.
- Best Poster Award : 2 awards (1 in Basic Research and 1 in Clinical Research).
- Best Case Report Award.

The BWGE and grants will be handed over during the Congress Dinner on Thursday March 5.
